## 4. RIDER MEETINGS

All athletes must be represented at the rider meeting or they will be removed from the start list. Rider meetings are typically held the night before each event. Athletes may be removed from the start list if they are not represented at the rider meeting. Check event schedules for times and locations.

## 5. REFUND POLICY

Entry fees will be refunded ONLY to athletes with a valid medical reason under the following provisions: Entry fees will be refunded if requested 2 weeks prior to first day of event onsite registration. Participants must have a valid medical reason with documentation and each case will be reviewed. A \$10 service charge will be deducted for all refunds.
