**To:** Elite Freeski, Freestyle & Snowboard athletes interested in participating in the 2025 FIS World Championship

**From:** U.S. Ski & Snowboard as the National Governing Body

**RE:** Preliminary Notice to the Athlete Selection Procedure for the World Championship 2025.

Final criteria for the 2025 World Championships in St Mortiz/Engadin, SUI will be released prior to the 2024/25 season. However, the opportunity exists for one athlete per gender to qualify over the 2023/24 season.

U.S. Ski & Snowboard will nominate the top one (1) U.S. athlete, respective of gender, ranked in the top three (3) on the 2025 FIS Base List. The following disciplines will be considered:

- Aerials
- Freeski Halfpipe
- Freeski Slopestyle
- Moguls
- Ski Cross
- Snowboard Cross
- Parallel Snowboard

U.S. Ski & Snowboard will nominate the top one (1) U.S. athlete, respective of gender, ranked in the top three (3) on the World Snowboard Points List (WSPL). The following disciplines will be considered:

- Snowboard Halfpipe
- Snowboard Slopestyle

Ties will be broken by each athlete's final World Cup Standings from the 2023/24 season in the respective discipline.
