



U.S. SKI & SNOWBOARD MEMBERSHIP

CROSS COUNTRY MEMBERSHIPS AND BENEFITS

May compete in: **Distance, Sprint**

U.S. Ski & Snowboard memberships may be upgraded during the same season; however, U.S. Ski & Snowboard does not downgrade, transfer, or refund memberships.

Adult members and those turning 18 at any time during the season are required to complete annual SafeSport training and periodic background screening* to activate membership. (Excludes Short-Term members.)

**Members turning 18 during the season, which runs July 1st – June 30th, will need to register for and receive a green-light background screening determination within 45 days of turning 18 to keep their membership activated.*

GENERAL MEMBER // AGE 0-17 // PRICE \$40

◆Does not include access to the U.S. Ski & Snowboard points list and not eligible for FIS License ◆

Allows an individual at the club level to participate and compete in activities such as:

- Training
- High School competition
- Community competition and/or general club activities

General Members can participate in NRL events, but they will be seeded in the last group with other General Members and Non-Scored Athletes.

NON-SCORED ATHLETE // AGE 18 and over // PRICE \$85

◆Does not include access to the U.S. Ski & Snowboard points list and not eligible for FIS License ◆

◆May not be accepted at all events. Please check race registration requirements. Not eligible for qualifying events. ◆

Provides access to all levels of U.S. Ski & Snowboard scored and non-scored competitions at the local, divisional, regional, and national level. **Does not include U.S. Ski & Snowboard points or ranking status.** Non-Scored Athletes will be seeded for race start purposes in the last seed, randomized with other Non-Scored Athletes and General Members.

COMPETITOR // AGE 13 and over // PRICE \$135

◆Required for FIS◆

An athlete competing in U.S. Ski & Snowboard scored and non-scored competitions at the local, divisional, regional and national level. Competitor memberships include scoring on national ranking lists as well as International Ski Federation (FIS) ranking lists, where appropriate (with additional FIS License). This membership is required for FIS registration and FIS level competitions (age restrictions apply).

Note: 2nd year U14s will **only** receive NRL points if they are racing in an event that is sanctioned for U16s or older athletes. Events sanctioned for U14 or younger athletes are NOT scored. U14 athletes **not intending to race up** against older athletes should purchase a **General Member** license.

FIS LICENSE // AGE Must be born in 2009 or prior // PRICE \$65

SHORT-TERM // AGE 0-17 // PRICE \$15/event

◆Does not include access to the U.S. Ski & Snowboard points list and not eligible for FIS License◆

◆May not be accepted at all events. Please check race registration requirements. Not eligible for qualifying events.◆

Short-Term memberships are limited to one (1) event per season. **Does not include access to the U.S. Ski & Snowboard points list. ADAPTIVE COMPETITOR // AGE 0-100 // PRICE \$80

An adaptive athlete with legs, arms or vision impairments competing in U.S. Ski & Snowboard Cross Country or Adaptive Cross Country events for national points. An Adaptive FIS license is required for Adaptive FIS-sanctioned events.

◆ *Not eligible for Coach or Official certifications or to be used in place of an Athlete membership.* ◆

For Board of Directors, club administrative staff, parents and club volunteers who undertake a leadership role in U.S. Ski & Snowboard clubs, divisions, regions and at competitions and club training sessions. **Applicable for those in a position of authority over or in regular contact with athletes.**
