Halfpipe, Slopestyle, & Big Air Snowboard World Cup Selection Criteria 2024-25

Eligibility for Consideration

U.S. Ski & Snowboard will consider for selection only those U.S. Ski & Snowboard members in good standing who have a valid U.S. passport, a valid USA-coded FIS license, and who meet FIS minimum eligibility standards.

Criteria Guidelines

- U.S. Ski & Snowboard policy mandates that team selection criteria shall be principally objective (or performance-based), but it may also select athletes to the team using coaches' discretion.
- The U.S. Ski & Snowboard Snowboard Sport Director is responsible for applying the selection criteria set forth herein.
- The team selected by U.S. Ski & Snowboard may consist of any number of athletes up to the FIS World Cup quota for the United States.
- The quota of start rights per nation is set annually by the FIS.
- The FIS has determined a maximum team size of ten (10) per nation. U.S. Ski & Snowboard will determine, at its discretion, the specific gender totals up to the maximum team size of ten (10), considering the maximum of six (6) per gender. Any additional quota granted by the FIS will be filled at the discretion of U.S. Ski & Snowboard.
- Athletes must meet the minimum FIS/WSPL point requirement at the time of event registration for entry into any World Cup:
 - Slopestyle - 120 FIS points or 230 WSPL
 - Halfpipe - 50 FIS points or 130 WSPL points
 - Big Air - 100 FIS Points or 230 WSPL points (both either Big Air or Slopestyle, whichever is higher)

(The count for additional nation quotas spots will exclude the names of competitors who earned elite spots from the World Cup ranking)."

- If coaches' discretion isn't utilized then the next highest ranked athletes on the most current WSPL according to highest rank on the Big Air and Slopestyle lists will be selected. Ties will be broken by Big Air rank.

DISCRETIONARY SELECTIONS

Athletes who have not met the objective criteria above may be selected to the team based on a variety of factors, including competitions outside of the selection period, and/or they satisfy any of the following:

- Outstanding competition results from the 2023/24 and 2024/2025 seasons, indicating a potential for success.
- Recent positive direction or trend of competition results indicating a potential for success.
- Indication of medal potential in future elite level competition (such as international age group results and age rankings) that would be materially enhanced by selection to the team.

U.S. SKI & SNOWBOARD APPEAL AND GRIEVANCE PROCEDURES

Any member who believes that he/she has wrongfully been denied membership on any team whose members are selected through participation in “Protected Competition,” as that term is defined in the USOPC Bylaws and U.S. Ski & Snowboard Bylaws, shall be entitled to appeal such a decision.
